Welcome to Community Academy Of Philadelphia's **Powerschool for Parents**. This information will get you started using PowerSchool. PowerSchool for Parents is easy to use and will allow you to take a more active role in your child's education.

PowerSchool offers parents real-time access to grades, attendance, homework assignments as well as class information. You can even e-mail teachers or ask for automatic updates on your student's progress and view the school bulletin. The PowerSchool link is available anywhere in the world, just by logging into the internet.

What is PowerSchool?

PowerSchool is a secure web-based system. With an internet connection, you can obtain school information about your child anytime. Powerschool is accessible from home, the office, the public library, or from any other computer with internet connection.

How will PowerSchool help me as a parent? You will be able to quickly check the following:
